

"Beyond Green Building and Codes: Seeing a Bigger Picture"



"Mr. Eisenberg will share insights from the last dozen years of working for deeper change in design, construction and building regulation. Using examples and stories from this work, David will speak about finding ways to work effectively with people who don't necessarily see the world as you do,

and the importance of grounding our work in positive outcomes, not just focusing on what we don't want. This talk will include information about alternative building materials, water issues, appropriate technology, civic planning, green energy and design, and more."

David Eisenberg, Co-founder and Director of the non-profit Development Center for Appropriate Technology (DCAT), has pioneered efforts to create a sustainable context for building regulation since 1995. He served two terms on the Board of Directors of the U.S. Green Building Council where he founded and chairs the USGBC Code Committee. He has written and presented extensively on sustainability and building regulation in the U.S. and abroad.
