Water Conservation Program Coordinator Shaun Rydell was recognized Wednesday afternoon at the monthly Upper Verde River Watershed Protection Coalition Board meeting for Water Smart Outstanding Leadership in Water Conservation, 2010.

Rydell was recognized for her work in regional water conservation education and outreach. In addition to her City of Prescott conservation duties, the City offered the UVRWPC her technical support in developing and implementing the UVRWPC community partners Water Smart education and product distribution program. The program includes a regional survey, coordinating the development, printing and distribution of educational materials, producing radio and print products

and public presentation in support of area-wide Water Smart education.

Water Smart racks provide residents practical water conservation information, and are located throughout the coalition member's municipal facilities. Information is free and designed to support water management by the water consumer. Educational print materials include: 12-UVRWPC Water Smart Cards, a full color comprehensive Central Yavapai County CONSERVATION handbook, printing of several University of Arizona Cooperative Extension Guides including a Well Owners Guide (AZ1451), Arsenic in AZ Ground Water (AZ1453) and Harvesting Rainwater For Landscape Use. Shaun has a BS in Community and Regional Planning, a CLIA Certified Irrigation Auditor and a WET - Water Education for Teachers - Facilitator.
