


Williamson Valley Road

RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

SUMMER/FALL 2011

On **Monday, August 22 from 5:30–7 p.m.** the City of Prescott and CLM Earthmovers invite you to attend a community meeting at the **Abia Judd Elementary School** for the Williamson Valley Road Reconstruction Project. The community meeting will provide information on the road widening construction process and project schedule.



This project is designed to improve a 0.75-mile City section of Williamson Valley Rd from Sidewinder Rd to Shadow Valley Ranch Rd by widening the road from two lanes to four. The project is anticipated to be complete by fall 2012. Once finished, this section of roadway will complete the Williamson Valley Rd widening effort from Iron Springs Rd within the Prescott city limits to Pioneer Parkway in Yavapai County.


Project benefits include:
