



# Household Hazardous Waste Day

The City of Prescott, Town of Dewey-Humboldt and Yavapai County are partnering to hold a Household Hazardous Waste Disposal Day. This service is available to City of Prescott residential solid waste customers, Town of Dewey-Humboldt residents and unincorporated Yavapai County residents.

## **Proof of residency is required:**

Driver's license or utility bill must be provided.

## **Acceptable items include:**

Acids, antifreeze, appliances, batteries, car batteries, cleaners, electronics, fluorescents, freon, fuel tanks, paint, paint remover, paint thinner, pesticides, smoke detectors, tires and used oil.

## **Prescription and over the counter drugs:**

Remove your pills/capsules/tablets from their containers and put them into a ziplock bag.

Liquids, salves, ointments and aerosols can stay in their original container.

Be sure the cap is tight, and then place them in a ziplock bag.

## **Unacceptable items include:**

Ammunition, asbestos, commercial (business) waste, commercial vehicle tires (tractors, tractor trailer, and heavy equipment), explosives, fireworks, home-generated medical waste, household garbage, items in plastic trash bags, radioactive waste or any other material or items not included as "acceptable" from list above.



## **Annual Cleanup Schedule**

- Monday routes will be picked up starting 3/31\*
- Tuesday routes will be picked up starting 4/7\*
- Wednesday routes will be picked up starting 4/14\*
- Thursday routes will be picked up starting 4/21\*
- Friday routes will be picked up starting 4/28\*

**\*ALL ITEMS MUST BE CURBSIDE BY 6 A.M. MONDAY OF THE DESIGNATED WEEK**

**City crews will sweep through neighborhoods ONE TIME ONLY and the route will be completed by Friday each week.**

### Annual Cleanup Rules:

1. All materials must be bagged, boxed or bundled for collection.
2. Tree limbs and lumber must be cut to four foot (4') lengths and tied.
3. Items must not weigh more than 75 pounds.
4. Appliances containing, or which have contained CFC's (freon) must be accompanied by a certificate from a licensed professional stating that the CFC's have been evacuated. Compressors and motors must be removed.
5. No tires, oil or lead acid type batteries will be collected.
6. No liquid paint, pesticides or other household hazardous wastes will be collected.
7. No contractor or demolition debris will be collected.
