**13** • Mayoral proclamation of Prescott's Bike Month 2010 - 3pm, City Hall

- Kickoff party at Coyote Joe's (after proclamation); enjoy taco and beer specials, live music, raffles, giveaways and the fine company of fellow bike enthusiasts!

**15** Green Drinks at the Raven Cafe - 4:30pm. At this month's Green Drinks gathering, discuss 'green transportation' – ie, biking! [Every third Thursday folks who work, or are interested, in sustainability or the environmental field meet up at the Raven for informal sessions known as Green Drinks.]

**16** Biking Basics - 5pm, meet at southside of Courthouse Square: learn basic bike handling skills and traffic laws then join a group ride around town; led by Paul Katan, PAT employee and League of American Bicyclists-certified instructor. Sponsored by PAT

**17** Ironclad Bicycles' Pre-Whiskey Event – 10-mile training ride at 12noon; barbecue at 2pm: everyone welcome to meet, ride and party with the locals who will endure the Whiskey Off-Road mt. bike race on 4/24; hosted and sponsored by Ironclad Bicycles (710 White Spar Rd)
