

WATER SAVING POSSIBILITIES


A two-bathroom household that is retrofitted with all of the proposed incentives (water efficient toilet, shower head, washing machine, point of demand hot water circulator, and provides leak repairs, turf removal) will save approximately 30,500 gallons of water per year.

The saving of water would amount to approximately 1400-acre feet of water saved per year at our current population. Imagine if every household adopts water-efficient plumbing devices, installs water wise landscape and if every household member would apply daily water conservation principals.

QUALIFYING CRITERIA

¹ LANDSCAPE CONVERSION TO AUTOMATIC DRIP SYSTEMS

The system when complete shall include the following irrigation components: (a) Automatic timer, (b) PVB - backflow prevention device (permit required), and (c) Drip irrigation water distribution system. Incentive award may represent the addition or combination of any one of these three (3) irrigation components.

² TURF REMOVAL ON-SITE AND IN ADJACENT RIGHT-OF-WAY

Requires the conversion from turf lawns to a water saving landscape. **Submit before and after pictures with turf credit application, as proof of turf removal.** If irrigation is required the conversion to drip irrigation or similar automated system is a requirement. Irrigation credit is also available in conjunction with the turf credit.

Incentive credit is \$0.50 per sq. ft and the following minimum turf removal applies:

- Residential minimum turf removal.....100 sq. ft.
- Non-Residential minimum turf removal..... 500 sq. ft.

³ WATER-EFFICIENT (WE) WASHING MACHINES

Purchase a new qualifying brand and model washing machine. Eligible models are listed on the Consortium for Energy Efficiency (CEE) website at www.cee1.org, link to residential clothes washer initiative. Eligible brand and models information is available at Public Works. Link on to the web at: www.cityofprescott.net — *Utilities—search for Water Conservation for more water saving ideas.*

PURPOSE of program is to encourage residents and business to conserve water. The award credits is designed to assist and promote the replacement of inefficient plumbing fixtures or high water use outdoor turf areas. Incentives are issued to water customers as a utility bill credit. Incentives are available for residential and non-residential customers.

INCENTIVE PROGRAM DATES are effective on March 30, 2006. Properties are eligible for a rebate if water efficient improvements, systems or conversion occur at the site on or after March 30, 2006. (dated documents supporting incentive credit are required)

ELIGIBILITY is open to all City of Prescott water utility customers. Your water utility accounts shall be current and in good standing. Only water efficient devices listed may be replaced, removed or retrofitted. Plumbing retrofits apply to construction or remodeling which took place prior to 1993.

1. All City of Prescott– Water Utility Customers
2. A building or remodel project constructed prior to **1993**. (plumbing fixture retrofits only)
3. Legal owners of record or an assigned agent (renters and commercial lease holders)
4. A homes of any age may apply for incentives for “WE” Wash Machines, Turf /lawn removal or drip irrigation sprinkler system with required permit.

Incentive award credits will not be issued for installing new plumbing fixtures or Hot Water recirculation pumps in new construction or additions permitted after 1993.

RENTALS AND LEASED PROPERTY are allowed to participate. Landlords wishing to support water conservation incentive retrofits in rental units shall fill out a separate application. Owners application is evidence that the legal owner is aware of and shall permit the lessee to carry-out plumbing or outdoor retrofits at the property. Attach a signed application to the lessee's incentive application. Credit shall only be applied to the water account associated with the retrofit address. Approved applications are subject to program criteria and verification.

PROCEDURES of incentive program require customers to complete and return the application, provide legible copies of dated supporting document as proof of purchase and/or installation. Proof may include receipts, contract agreements and if required, a building permit.

APPROVED APPLICANT SHALL AGREE TO A SITE VERIFICATION. In an effort to audit the Water Incentive Programs effectiveness, approved applicants shall allow the city agent to verify the installation of the water saving incentive awarded. Site visits shall be randomly selected and by appointment. *Authorized credits may be subject to repayment if false claims for incentive awards are found.*

INCENTIVE AWARDS are administered by the City of Prescott—Public Works Department. Application are received on a first-come, first-serve basis. At no time will any applicant be allowed to receive more than one-half (1/2) of the monies remaining for a specific item incentive awards.

Incentive awards are provided only as a **credit on the property's water bill(s)** and not as a check or other payment. Credit will be applied according to information provided on the approved application. Utility customers can expect a credit to their account within three (3) utility billing periods. Credit when applied to utility billing account is at the sole discretion of the Utility Billing Department.

APPLICATIONS are available at: City Hall, Public Works and throughout community business locations. Please complete all customer areas, estimate your credits, take pictures, sign your application, cut form from instruction, Copy all required receipts and return your complete application and attachments to City of Prescott Public Works:

1. **Application**—Incentive Program (See your utility bill for water meter# and account information)
2. **Copy of required receipts**, pictures, contracts or proof of purchase.
3. **Lease's and landlord** must return two(2) signed applications authorizing retrofits.

Note: *Incomplete application will be returned and credits shall not be processed.*

ADMINISTRATION OF THIS PROGRAM shall be at the discretion of the Program Director and Water Conservation Coordinator. The director may designate additional staff or volunteers to assist with procedures. Applications shall receive a time and date stamp upon receipt. Coordinator shall approve application in accordance with the ordinance No. 4527 adopted 02/28/06.
